3a) ...Only in case you cannot proof 20 credits in tourism and economics: Proof at least 10 credits or an equivalent amount of hours of course work in a tourism related subject <u>AND</u> at least 10 credits or an equivalent amount of hours of course work in a business/economics related subject (e.g.: business administration, economics etc.)?		
3b) ...Only in case you cannot proof a Diploma or Bachelor Degree in one of the studies above: 3 years of work experience in a touristic company or a touristic institution in a position of responsibility with, e.g., budget- and/or staff responsibility which can be proved by reference letters?
